To ensure the best possible visit, The Frick Collection has established the following guidelines for visiting school groups. We hope these guidelines will help you in scheduling and preparing for your visit.

1. Please arrive no more than ten minutes in advance of your scheduled school visit. The front doors open precisely at 10:00 a.m. Tuesday through Saturday.
2. Please leave large bags and backpacks at school or inside the bus, as this helps streamline entry into The Frick Collection.
3. Please note that any group arriving more than 30 minutes late cannot be guaranteed its scheduled guided visit. If your group anticipates a late arrival to the museum, please contact the Education Department at (212) 547-0672 and we will try to accommodate you at the time of your arrival.
4. If you are scheduled for a guided visit, please divide your class into equal groups of ten or fewer students *before* entering the building. This will help us start the visit on time.
5. Please remind your students to silence their cell phones before entering the building.
6. Please remind students that food, drink, gum, etc. are not permitted in the galleries.
7. Drawing with pencils and paper is permitted in the galleries of The Frick Collection; use of charcoal, pastels, oil paints, watercolors, etc. is prohibited.
8. The Frick Collection does not provide a lunchroom or refreshment services.
9. Fees are non-refundable unless due to weather restriction.
