Frick Art Reference Library: Public Services Department

The Public Services Department of the Frick Art Reference Library (FARL) is now accepting applications for summer 2013 for a summer intern to assist in the field of art information and in providing assistance for researchers accessing the Library in person or remotely. Involvement in the everyday activities of the Department and the institution will be coupled with the development of an independent project that will enhance the services available at the Library.

Eligibility

The Public Services internship is open to a qualified graduate student in art history, library and information science, or other relevant fields. Scheduling is flexible and depends on the needs of the department and the availability of the intern. The internship is unpaid, and the intern is responsible for his or her own housing and travel arrangements.

Application Instructions

Please note that eligibility and application instructions may vary from one museum department to another and that multiple applications cannot be accepted; please apply to only one department per season. All internship applications must be submitted via e-mail.
