SUMMER 2013 INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Frick Art Reference Library: The Center for the History of Collecting Department

The Center for the History of Collecting in America is now accepting applications for a summer 2013 internship. The intern will assist with research and data entry for the Center's *Archives Directory for the History of Collecting in America*.

The Directory is a database whose records identify and locate primary materials relating to American collectors of fine and decorative arts. Records pertain not only to the collectors themselves, but also to dealers (both American and foreign) from whom they purchased works of art and to advisers/consultants who helped shape the collectors' taste in art.

Eligibility

The Center for the History of Collecting Internship is open to a qualified undergraduate or graduate student in art history or other relevant fields. Attention to detail is essential and a strong interest in the history of collecting in America is desirable. Intern activities are generally carried out four days a week between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., although an alternative schedule may be discussed. All internships are unpaid, and applicants are responsible for their own housing and travel arrangements.

Application Instructions

Please note that eligibility and application instructions may vary from one museum department to another and that multiple applications cannot be accepted; please apply to only one department per season. All internship applications must be submitted via e-mail.

- Please write a cover letter in the e-mail body that includes:
 - Your reasons for applying to the Frick Art Reference Library
 - Your contact information
 - The names, professional affiliations, and telephone numbers of two professors, or one professor and one employer, who may be contacted as references.
- Please attach your résumé as a PDF.

All Center for the History of Collecting Internship applications for summer 2013 must be received no later than March 1, 2013. No phone calls, please. Selected candidates will be contacted for interviews, and applicants will be notified by the end of April.
