## **Background**

The Frick Collection is an art museum consisting of more than 1,400 works of art from the thirteenth to the nineteenth century, displayed in the intimate surroundings of the former home of Henry Clay Frick. The residence, with its furnishings and works of art, has been open to the public since 1935. The Frick Art Reference Library is an internationally-recognized research library that serves as one of the most complete resources for the study of Western art. Founded in 1920, the Library today holds more than one million study photographs, 285,000 books, 80,000 auction catalogs, and 2,250 periodical titles. It is open to interested individuals from all over the world.

## **Position Summary**

The Frick Collection provides luncheon service for approximately 150 employees five days/week. The kitchen also routinely prepares luncheons and other meals for special events, the Director' Office, Board of Directors, and their guests. The Line Cook assists with set-up, food prep, cooking and serving lunch. S/he assists in sorting and storing perishable and nonperishable deliveries and helps housekeeping staff with kitchen clean-up.

## **Requirements**

High School Diploma or GED, Culinary Degree, 2 years' experience in Employee Dining Service or Cafeteria. Food Safety Certificate preferred. Bi-lingual English/Spanish or French useful. Physical requirements include: lifting 50 pounds to the waist, i.e. kitchen equipment and supplies.
