DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The past fiscal year was full of milestones, unprecedented presentations, and exciting developments. Most significant was the one-year anniversary of the museum and library's temporary residency at Frick Madison, which opened to the public in March 2021. This year also marked the hundred-year anniversary of the Frick Art Reference Library, whose world-class resources and innovative digital offerings serve a community of local and international scholars. These projects and our ever-expanding outreach are owed, in large part, to the unwavering support of our generous community, with whom we celebrate all the successes of the past year.

The Frick Madison installation in Marcel Breuer's stunning modernist masterpiece at 945 Madison Avenue has enabled us to consider the collection in satisfying new ways. Following collaborations with contemporary voices in recent years—including exhibitions by Edmund de Waal and Arlene Shechet—in the fall of 2021 we launched the year-long project *Living Histories: Queer Views and Old Masters*. This groundbreaking series showcased one new work each by four New York-based artists, who responded to specific paintings from our Dutch and Northern European holdings, with particular emphasis on issues of gender and sexuality typically excluded from narratives of early modern European art. In September, Salman Toor's *Museum Boys*

and Doron Langberg's *Lover* went on view alongside, respectively, Johannes Vermeer's *Officer and Laughing Girl* and *Mistress and Maid* and Hans Holbein the Younger's *Sir Thomas More*. In January, Jenna Gribbon's *What Am I Doing Here? I Should Ask You the Same* was displayed in conversation with the work of Holbein. The final installment was Toyin Ojih Odutola's monumental drawing *The Listener*, shown into September in dialogue with Rembrandt's *Nicolaes Ruts* and *Self-Portrait*. Co-organized by Deputy Director and Peter Jay Sharp Chief Curator Xavier F. Salomon and Curator Aimee Ng, *Living Histories* was well received by both the public and the press: *The New Yorker* called the "unconventional proximity" of the contemporary works to the Frick's Old Masters "a delight," while *W Magazine* remarked how the Frick was "elevating young queer artists to celestial heights."

From March 2022, *Propagazioni: Giuseppe Penone at Sèvres* presented eleven never-before-shown porcelain disks by the acclaimed Arte Povera artist. The works were created during Penone's 2013 residency at the Sèvres manufactory in France, where many renowned objects in the Frick's decorative arts collection were made during the eighteenth century. Penone's beautifully subtle disks—which challenge the distinctions between art and nature, sculpture and painting, seeing and touching—were presented adjacent to the porcelain



room at Frick Madison, which features notable European and Asian examples in the medium. A catalogue by Assistant Curator of Sculpture Giulio Dalvit and Xavier F. Salomon accompanied the installation, just one of several titles the Frick published this year. (For a full list of publications, please see page 8.)

This fiscal year, the Frick received more than two hundred portrait medals, the generous gift of Stephen K. and Janie Woo Scher. Created in Italy, France, Germany, and other European countries between the early fifteenth and the late nineteenth century, these objects are part of a larger promised gift of medals made by the Schers. Numbering more than one thousand medals in total, the gift represents the largest acquisition in the museum's history and enables the Frick to study and present portrait medals as an artistic tradition unto itself.

In August 2021, we announced the promised gift of twenty-five pastels and drawings and one oil sketch from the collection of Board Chair Elizabeth Eveillard and her husband, Jean-Marie. Highlights include sheets by François Boucher, John Constable, Edgar Degas, Jean-Honoré Fragonard, Francisco de Goya, Jean-Antoine Watteau, and others that deepen our Old Master holdings. The gift will also introduce works by artists not previously represented in the collection, such as a signed sketch by Élisabeth-Louise Vigée Le Brun, a preparatory drawing for Gustave

Caillebotte's iconic *Paris Street; Rainy Day*, and a study by John Singer Sargent for his infamous *Portrait of Madame X*.

The ongoing renovation and enhancement project at our historic Fifth Avenue home continued in full force, led by Selldorf Architects, preservation architects Beyer Blinder Belle, and the Frick's capital projects and operations teams. Notable milestones over the past year include the excavation of the 70th Street Garden; the restoration of the Garden Court fountain; and the de-installation of the Boucher Room in anticipation of its move to the mansion's second floor, which, upon reopening, will be accessible to the public for the first time. In August 2021, we announced the receipt of an award from the inaugural grant cycle of the Helen Frankenthaler Foundation's Climate Initiative to support the replacement of the skylights over three galleries and the Garden Court with more energy-efficient systems, which will protect the historic spaces and further overall sustainability. This improvement will help us to achieve the renovation project's goal of securing LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certification.

To engage our growing audiences from home, the education department continued to create new offerings to complement existing programs. The department is now led by April Kim Tonin, whom we welcomed in September 2021 as the institution's first Ayesha Bulchandani Head of Education and Public Engagement, a title that honors the family of Trustee Ayesha Bulchandani and her longstanding commitment to education and outreach at the Frick.

Online visits for schools, colleges, and universities served nearly 2,800 students this fiscal year, providing an introduction to our collection, guided close-looking sessions, and targeted curriculum-focused discussions. We offered a small number of in-person tours as well, marking the beginning of a measured return to gallery teaching following the long shutdown necessitated by the COVID-19 pandemic. Online sessions of *Continue the Conversation* were held bimonthly, with additional sessions offered for members. The popular program welcomed participants from as nearby as Flatbush and as far afield as Pakistan, who joined our educators for participatory conversations centered on favorite works from the permanent collection as well as others from the *Living Histories* series. We continued to offer monthly sessions of *Drawing Together*, our contemplative sketching program held live online, as well as reintroducing onsite drawing programs at Frick Madison. All virtual programs continued to include live captioning, with other access services available by request, and in summer 2021 the department piloted simultaneous Spanish captioning during its Intern Showcases.

Throughout the year, Frick educators offered online sessions to our longtime community partners, including Columbia University's Art Humanities program, the Creative Center at University Settlement, Hunter College, Sanctuary for Families, the East Harlem School, the Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis School at American Ballet Theatre, and CUNY Arts.

During the summer, we held a virtual table read for The Frick Film Project—a

collaboration with the Ghetto Film School that began in 2015. Actors Chris Rock, Christian Slater, and Michael Shannon were among the readers, and critiques were provided by film industry leaders. Two student films were shot onsite at Frick Madison in September, and all of the films produced in 2021 and 2022 were shown at a private screening in April 2022.

The Frick Art Reference Library had numerous projects of note over the past fiscal year, including the launch of an updated online catalog of its collection, which went live in November 2021. This undertaking involved the transfer of massive quantities of data to the new platform hosted by the New York Art Resources Consortium (NYARC). The new catalog can be accessed at library.frick.org.

As part of its centennial celebrations, the library debuted *One Hundred Years at the Library*, an ongoing video and blog series that explores its first hundred years through various objects from its collections. The library also pursued a variety of other web-based projects, indicative of its commitment to furthering digital art history research. In partnership with the Internet Archive and NYARC, the Frick was one of more than thirty art and museum libraries across the United States to collaborate on the preservation of vital arts content from the internet. The initiative, the Collaborative ART Archive (CARTA), is supported by a grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) to build an ongoing archive of ephemeral webpages of artists, galleries, and other cultural sites.

As part of the ongoing NEH Photoarchive grant, nearly 6,400 negatives and transparencies and more than 17,000 images of sculptures were digitized by the end of 2021. The Mellon Foundation Pilot Project grant for PHAROS, the international consortium of photo archives, was extended through June 2022, and the project to match all 40,000-plus names of artists represented in the Photoarchive to files in Wikidata was completed by the end of 2021.

In January 2022, the Frick acquired the archives of the transatlantic art dealer Rosenberg & Stiebel, one of the last major dealer archives held in private hands. The acquisition was the generous gift of Gerald G. Stiebel and his wife, Penelope Hunter-Stiebel, who also donated the archives of her art historical and curatorial work at The Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Portland Art Museum, and various independent projects. By the summer of 2022, the materials from both gifts were available to researchers onsite in the reading room and online. These acquisitions were overseen by Sally Brazil, who this year was named the first Barbara G. Fleischman Associate Chief Librarian for Archives and Records Management.

This year marked the debut of Cheng-Harrell Open Nights, a series of free evenings held seasonally at Frick Madison that offer after-hours museum and reading room access, gallery talks, live music, sketching, and more. The first Open Night, on June 17, marked the return to large-scale public programming following the pandemic shutdown. In celebration of Pride Month, it featured activities

inspired by *Living Histories: Queer Views and Old Masters*, including a panel discussion with *Living Histories* artists Jenna Gribbon, Salman Toor, and Doron Langberg, in conversation with writer and cultural critic Roxane Gay. The discussion, moderated by Chief Curator Xavier F. Salomon, was livestreamed to at-home audiences on YouTube. The Frick is grateful to Trustee Tai-Heng Cheng and Cole Harrell for their generous sponsorship of these popular evenings.

Our residency at Frick Madison has presented increased opportunities to engage with our neighbors on Madison Avenue. In June 2021, Elizabeth Daly, Community Relations Manager, was elected to the Board of Directors of the Madison Avenue Business Improvement District. We participated in a number of events hosted by that organization, offering activities for the public on the sidewalk in front of Frick Madison during Welcome Back Saturdays and Shop with Your Dog Day in September 2021, the Fall Gallery Walk in October 2021, and the Spring Gallery Walk in May 2022.

Continuing with the exponential growth of online offerings prompted by the pandemic, we developed countless digital programs and content for audiences to enjoy onsite, from home, or on the go. The Frick's mobile guide hosted on the Bloomberg Connects app continued to be expanded, including translating the content into Spanish. The Frick Madison virtual tour was published on our website; we launched *Frick Focus*, an Instagram Reels series of thirty-second close looks at works on view at Frick Madison; and we debuted *Where in the*

World?, a video series spotlighting connections between European works in the collection and the wider world.

On September 13, 2021, the Frick's Instagram page received a record one thousand new followers in a single day following the live broadcast—viewed more than two million times within twenty-four hours—of an after-hours video installation/performance realized at Frick Madison by artist JR and featuring actor Timothée Chalamet, prior to Chalamet's arrival at the 2021 Met Gala. Additionally, videos shared on the Frick's YouTube channel received 1.3 million views, and we added more than 11,000 new YouTube subscribers during calendar year 2021.

Our development team had a stellar year, raising funds to support the museum and library's many activities and initiatives, as well as capital campaign gifts that will ensure the vitality of the institution for future generations. Our membership department worked hard to attract new members to join our community; notably, by the end of the fiscal year, the number of Young Fellows was the highest in the institution's history. One indication of our members' engagement was demonstrated by the success of our Annual Fund campaign: an impressive \$2.1 million was raised, with more than \$1.4 million contributed during November and December alone, thanks in large part to a generous Annual Fund matching grant from Trustee Stephen A. Schwarzman.

We were pleased to be able to once again offer in-person member and benefit events, many of which had been

postponed or adapted to an online format due to COVID-19 precautions. On September 28, 2021, Chief Conservator Joe Godla and I gave presentations at the Behind-the-Scenes Luncheon, held at the Cosmopolitan Club, discussing the move to Frick Madison and developments on the renovation and enhancement project.

We held our elegant fall benefit, the Autumn Dinner, on October 18, 2021, at the Metropolitan Club, honoring Ronald S. Lauder's exceptional contributions to the Frick and to cultural and philanthropic causes around the world. The event raised more than \$1.3 million in support of education programs, conservation projects, special exhibitions, and other activities of the museum and library. We ended 2021 with two seasonal events—Holiday Cheer, on December 8, and a festive celebration for new members, on December 16.

On March 31, 2022, after a two-year hiatus, we welcomed more than five hundred guests to the Young Fellows Ball, the first to be hosted at Frick Madison. The event's theme, inspired by the *Living Histories* installation, was "Modern Love." The ball—which was generously sponsored by Saks Fifth Avenue, First Republic Bank, and Carolina Herrera—received substantial press coverage, including write-ups in *Vogue* and *Women's Wear Daily*. The Spring Garden Party for Fellows and Young Fellows took place on May 23—also for the first time at Frick Madison—with some six hundred in attendance. The evening featured live jazz music and talks in the Van Dyck, Italian, and Fragonard galleries. On June 21, we hosted the first Frick Future

Member Celebration to recognize those loyal individuals who continued to renew and maintain active memberships during our residency at Frick Madison. The event included gallery talks and a brief update on the ongoing renovation project and was livestreamed for those unable to join in person. Finally, on June 27, we held Pride at the Frick: A Cheng-Harrell Midsummer Evening, a Pride Month celebration for Fellows and Young Fellows featuring live music and gallery talks.

In December 2021, we were saddened to lose a longtime friend of the Frick, Trustee Sidney R. Knafel. Sid served on the Board of Trustees for nearly a decade, giving generously to a number of special exhibitions over the years as well as being among the first to support the renovation project. In addition to his successful business leadership and exemplary philanthropy, Sid had one of the world's finest collections of French faience. He shared his passion for collecting during his tenure on the Board by advocating for the creation of an acquisitions fund; acquiring two important works for the museum, a pair of exquisite candelabra by Pierre Gouthière and a rare Saint-Porchaire ewer; and ultimately promising seventy-five of his best faience pieces to the museum. Sid will forever be remembered for his kindness, generosity, and enthusiasm for the collection.

The past fiscal year saw developments in our ongoing efforts to strengthen diversity, equity, access, and inclusion (DEAI) across the institution. DEAI councils were formed both by our Trustees and by a volunteer group of staff members, the former meeting regularly with

an outside consultant and the latter meeting biweekly beginning in April 2022 to formulate its scope and function. Strides in this area were recognized by the New York State Assembly, which honored the Frick on May 4 in Albany with a citation for our longstanding efforts to employ people with disabilities and our commitment to an inclusive workplace. We are proud of the fact that the Frick was one of only four employers and the only cultural institution to receive this notable distinction.

As we celebrate Frick Madison's first anniversary, the centenary of the Frick Art Reference Library, and the progress of the renovation of our historic buildings, I remain ever grateful to the members of the Frick community. I would be remiss not to express special thanks as well to our incredible staff members, who work tirelessly to keep our buildings and collections safe, develop engaging programs, raise vital funds to support all our activities, conserve important objects, welcome guests to the galleries, and so much more. Our work is made possible by the unwavering dedication of our friends and donors, whose support allows us to create unprecedented and innovative experiences with our renowned collection and to envision even greater offerings as we look to the future. On behalf of the Board of Trustees and the entire staff, I look forward to celebrating many more milestones at Frick Madison and at our permanent home on East 70th Street.

Note 1

For purposes of brevity, the June 30, 2022, financial information presented here is excerpted from our audited financial statements as prepared by the independent accounting firm of PKF O'Connor Davies, LLP, which rendered an unmodified opinion as to those statements' conformance with generally accepted accounting principles. This excerpted information does not include the Statement of Cash Flows or the footnotes, which are integral to a full presentation of the institution's financial position. A complete Report of the Independent Auditors is available by writing to the development office of The Frick Collection.

Note 2: Measure of Operations

Operations include all revenues and expenses that are an integral part of the Frick's programs and supporting activities. The measure of operations includes investment income equal to the 4.5% spending rate (see Note 3) and excludes investment return in excess of, or less than, the spending rate. The measure of operations also excludes permanently restricted contributions; purchase and sale of museum and library collection items; unsolicited, unrestricted contributions of \$50,000 or more (which are designated by the Board of Trustees as contributions to the *Campaign for the Frick: Honoring the Past and Enhancing the Future*); depreciation of property and equipment; pension and post-retirement plan adjustments; and releases of net assets from restrictions related to non-operating items.

Note 3: Spending Rate

The Frick Collection manages its pooled investments on a total return basis. To preserve the investments' long-term purchasing power, the Frick makes available to be spent each year a percentage of the investment portfolio's average market value for the twelve quarters ending the March prior to the beginning of the fiscal year (the spending rate). The spending rate was 4.5% for fiscal years 2022 and 2021. Although long-term in nature, this policy may be modified over time to reflect economic, market, and investment changes.
