# GARDEN COURT AND JAMES S. AND BARBARA N. REIBEL RECEPTION HALL

Modeled after a Roman atrium, the room features a vaulted skylight and paired Ionic columns surrounding a tranquil pool and fountain. With bronze and porcelain sculptures displayed among the greenery, the Garden Court is a magnificent setting for everything from a cocktail reception to a formal dinner.
